Students have the opportunity to utilize the knowledge they have gained in the classroom and see how their studies translate into a professional setting. Qualifications for the KeNHA Internship Program 2017/2018

- A Diploma or a First degree from a recognized Institution in the following disciplines: Civil Engineering, Finance/Accounting, Survey, Economics, Sociology, GIS, Environmentalist, Procurement Studies, Human Resource Management, ICT, Law, Business Administration, Business Management, Statistics, Communications and Public Relations.
- Be a Kenyan youth aged between 20 and 34 years.
- Must attach a valid personal accident insurance cover.
- Must have completed their training and graduated in the last 2 (two) years.
- Must not have undertaken any other internship programme or exposed to work experience related to their area of study since graduation.

Personal Attributes

- Must be a person of Integrity (Current Certificate of good Conduct required)
- Must be Computer Literate
- Strong Communication (written & oral) skills
