The Kenya National Highways Authority (KeNHA) is a State Corporation established under the Kenya Roads Act, 2007, with the responsibility for the management, development, rehabilitation and maintenance of national roads.

The Kenya National Highways Authority in conjunction with **Coast Water Services Board** now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for **RELOCATION OF WATER PIPELINES FROM CHANGAMWE ROUNDABOUT TO MAKUPA ROUNDABOUT ALONG THE PROJECT ROAD.**

The source of fund to be used is Government of Kenya (GoK) Development Fund.

The following are mandatory requirements that **must** be submitted together with the bids

- **Certified** copy of certificate of incorporation
- Copy of valid Tax Compliance Certificate (To be verified on KRA TCC Checker).
- **Certified** copy of Valid NCA certificate under Category 1 for water works
- **Certified** copy of Current Single Business permit
- Current work load
- Litigation history (provide sworn affidavit) should have been sworn within 3 months of the tender opening date
- Client satisfaction on previous and current assignments
- Duly filled Confidential Business Questionnaire
- Bidders shall sequentially serialize all pages of each tender submitted

All Certification of Documents shall be original and executed by a Commissioner for Oaths or Notaries Public.
