



ROADS10,000 PROGRAMME: THE DEVELOPMENT OF 10,000KM OF ROADS SUPPORTING PRIMARY GROWTH SECTORS THROUGH CONTRACTOR FACILITATED FINANCING MECHANISM (PHASE 1)

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR THE INDEPENDENT EXPERT FOR ILLASIT- NJUKINI-TAVETA ROAD (LOT 32): TENDER NO. KeNHA/1993/2018

1. The Government of the Republic of Kenya through the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing and Urban Development represented by the Kenya National Highways Authority (KeNHA), a State Corporation established under the Kenya Roads Act, 2007 requires the services of a consulting firm to act as an Independent Expert for Illasit – Njukini- Taveta Road under the Public Private Partnership Programme. The Roads 10,000 Programme intends to support the primary growth sectors of Commerce, Tourism, Agriculture and Rural Production, and Extractive Industries.
2. Illasit – Njukini- Taveta road (B55) in Taiva- Taveta County is Lot 32 of the Annuity Roads10,000 Programme and is 66.55km long.
3. Broadly the scope of works will include upgrading to bitumen standards of gravel and earth roads and rehabilitation/reconstruction of bridges, culverts, road intersections, drains, etc. The approach under this programme will be based on the Finance-Design-Build-Maintain and Transfer Contract Framework over a 10-year period.
4. The Authority therefore invites eligible Consulting Engineering Firms with the capability (Qualification and Experience) to express their interest to assist the parties in the management of the implementation of the Project Agreement between the Authority and the Project Company (Service Provider) for the project under a Public Private Partnership (PPP) framework.
5. The consultancy services to be provided by the Independent Expert shall involve monitoring compliance with the terms of the Project Agreement by the parties to the contract during the project period.
6. Interested firms must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services which should include; Firms experience in similar assignments on PPP framework of NOT less than five (5) years, availability of experienced Key Staff in project finance and financial analysis, experience in PPP contract management moreso in monitoring performance standards etc.). Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications.
7. Eligibility criteria, establishment of the short-list and the selection procedure shall be in accordance with the Public Private Partnership (PPP) Act, 2013 (download from this [URL:http://www.pppunit.go.ke/news/view/public-private-partneship-act-2013](http://www.pppunit.go.ke/news/view/public-private-partneship-act-2013)).
8. Association with local firms will be an added advantage during evaluation of proposals. International firms are therefore encouraged to form Joint Ventures, and Associations with local firms.
