



TENDER NOTICE

STAGE IMPROVEMENT OF NAIBOR – MARALAL (A4), MAU NAROK – KISIRIRI (B20) AND UGUNJA – RUAMBWA (C192) ROADS

The Kenya National Highways Authority (KeNHA) is a State Corporation established under the Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with the responsibility for Management, Development, Rehabilitation and Maintenance of National Trunk Roads.

The Authority hereby invites bids from eligible contractors for stage Improvement of three (3 No.) Roads Naibor – Marala (A4), Mau Narok – Kisiriri (B20) and Ugunja – Ruambwa (C192) Roads to be funded through the Development Vote. The roads will be constructed up to sub base level and sealed with double surface dressing as per the provided designs. The roads are listed below:

QUALIFICATION FOR TENDERING

Mandatory Requirements

The following must be submitted together with bid:

1. **Certified** copy of Registration Certificate with the **National Construction Authority (NCA) in the stated categories.**
2. **Certified** copy of Certificate of incorporation
3. Copy of **Valid** Tax Compliance Certificate (Will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker)
4. **Certified** copy of **Valid** Single Business Permit.
5. **Certified** copy of CR12 form
6. All foreign contractors must source **at least forty percent** of their supplies from citizen contractors and must submit a declaration of compliance together with their tender
7. Bidders **must serialize** all pages for each bid document submitted.

Note: All certification of documents must be original and executed by a **commissioner for oaths.**

Other Requirements

As specified in the tender documents covering the following: -

1. Similar previous experience
2. Professional and technical personnel
3. Equipment holding
4. Current work load
5. Litigation history **Current** Sworn Affidavit (i.e. within three months of the tender opening date)
6. Eligibility:
 - a. Only those bidders registered in the NCA category as indicated in the tender document shall bid for the respective tenders.
 - b. Bidders with history of Non-performance (e.g. failure to complete the projects for the last three (3) Financial Years, Notice of termination or termination of contracts in the last three (3) Financial Years will be disqualified.
 - c. A bidder can only be awarded one tender under this Tender Notice.
 - d. Directors bidding under different companies for the same tender shall be disqualified.
7. Any form of canvassing will lead to disqualification.

Procurement shall be based on the post qualification method and the above details will be submitted with the priced bid.

There shall be a **mandatory pre-tender site visits** as specified in the table above.

NOTE: Every Bidder shall be represented by one person bearing a letter from the company authorizing them to represent the company in the pre tender site visit. Each person attending shall strictly represent one (1) company.

The letter shall be in the official company letter head giving name and ID/Passport No. of the representative who shall be required to present their Original Identification during the pre-tender site visit.
