The Government of the Republic of Kenya has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Horn of Africa Gateway Development Project (HoAGDP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Package 1: Upgrading of Isiolo – Kulamawe - Modogashe (A10/B84) Road, comprising of two Lots as listed below:

**This Request for Bids is under Package 1 which comprises of two (2) Lots: Lot 1 (Isiolo – Kulamawe) and Lot 2 (Kulamawe – Modogashe). Bidders can participate in Lot 1 or Lot 2 or both as they qualify.**

For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing.

2. The Kenya National Highways Authority, a State Corporation under the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing, Urban Development and Public Works established under the Kenya Roads Act, 2007, now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the contract for construction of the above lots:

The scope of works includes, but is not limited to, the following activities, to be executed within a period of 42 months:

#### Lot 1: Isiolo - Kulamawe:

- Construction of road pavement to attain a 7m carriageway width with 2m shoulders on each side using materials such as surface dressing, asphalt concrete (superpave specification), cement stabilized or cement improved gravel base, cement improved gravel subbase and associated earthworks
- Construction of grade separated interchange at A2/A10 junction, bridges, culverts and other drainage infrastructure
- Construction of truck parking, roadside amenities, access roads, junctions, bus bays
- Full and consistent compliance with environmental, social, health and safety safeguards
- Construction and maintenance of deviation roads and passage of traffic
- Construction of fibre optic cable civil works

#### Lot 2: Kulamawe - Modogashe and Gar-batula Loop road:

- Construction of road pavements to attain a 7m carriageway width with 2m shoulders on each side using materials such as surface dressing, asphalt concrete (superpave specification), cement stabilized or cement improved gravel base, cement improved gravel subbase and associated earthworks
- Construction of bridges, culverts, and other drainage infrastructure
- Construction of truck parking, roadside amenities, access roads, junctions, bus bays
- Full and consistent compliance with environmental, social, health and safety safeguards
- Construction and maintenance of deviation roads and passage of traffic
- Construction of fibre optic cable civil works along Kulamawe – Modogashe – Samatar (218km)

3. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers- Procurement in Investment Projects Financing" Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, (*Procurement in Investment Project Financing: Goods, Works, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services*) issued on July 2016, Revised November 2017 and August 2018 ("*Procurement Regulations*"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
