Reference is made to the Tender Notice published on on My Gov newspaper on 10<sup>th</sup> February, 2026 and subsequently uploaded on the KeNHA website and PPIP.

Pursuant to the provisions of Clause 7 of the Conditions of Tender and Instructions to Tenderers, the following clarifications have been made concerning the Question submitted to us.

1.	<p>On the Tender Documents- Qualifications Criteria, Part A, No. 20 on Rates Derivation and also on the Form for Detailed Breakdown of Cost Comparison, there is a statement "<i>Bidder shall provide / Attach current (at least 30 days before tender opening date) proof of cost of materials e.g. Pro forma Invoices/quotations.</i>"</p> <p>We believe the word current and the phrase at least 30 days are contradictory and create a logical conflict. We suggest the phrase "<i>at least</i>" be <b>replaced</b> with "<i>at most</i>" or "<i>not more than</i>".</p> <p>Please clarify.</p>	<p>The Bidders are required to provide proof of cost of materials e.g. Pro forma Invoices/ quotations as indicated in the Qualifications Criteria and Form for Detailed Breakdown of Cost Comparison. This proof of cost of materials should be dated within 30 days prior to the Tender opening date.</p>
2.	<p>Section 98 (1) of the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015 states that "Upon advertisement, the accounting officer of a procuring entity shall immediately provide copies of the tender documents in accordance with the invitation to tender and the accounting officer shall upload the tender document on the website."</p> <p>Some of the tender documents are yet to be uploaded. Further, the Eligibility criteria on part 4 (b) states that Director (s) and Bidders who have been awarded Tenders in this Financial Year (FY 2025-2026) are not eligible to bid for this Tender Notice.</p> <p>We therefore request that you first conclude the initial procurement before proceeding with mandatory pre-bid conference and pre-tender site visits.</p>	<p>The previous procurement process is complete and the outcome of the process communicated to the participating bidders.</p> <p>The pre-tender site visits and pre-bid conference dates for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter FY 2025-2026 Maintenance Tenders remains as stated in the Long Tender Notice.</p>


